### THE CURRENT LANDSCAPE IN THE PHILIPPINES

- Philippines remains one of Asia's fastest-growing HIV epidemics.
- 4,979 new HIV cases (Apr–Jun 2025) with 55 new cases daily\*
- COVID-19 accelerated adoption of digital and community-led health models

#### **Key Barriers to HIV Access**

- Distance
- Shortage of Healthcare Workers
- Money
- Stigma and Discrimination



#### HOW OUR VIRTUAL HIV SERVICES WORKS


- HIV (Self-Test Kits and PrEP)
  - Bookings via Facebook Messenger, guided by the Embrace Chatbot for screening, scheduling, and support.
  - Free HIV Self-Test Kits and PrEP provided nationwide, clients only shoulder the delivery fee.
  - Integrated eCommerce and courier system used to process, pack, and deliver orders faster, nationwide, and discreetly.
- Consultations (Virtual doctors for consults and prescriptions)
  - Virtual consultations conducted through Google Meet, Viber, or EMR-based teleconsultation systems.
  - Covers HIV treatment, sexual health, and general medical concerns.
  - Telehealth Associates and Peer Counselors assist clients throughout the process.





### EARLY IMPACT AND REACH

Data from April to June 2025. Figures reflect Embrace Virtual Hub only, other hubs (Amping, Kabayan, and PLUS) are newly launched and still expanding.



## CHALLENGES & LESSONS LEARNED FROM GOING VIRTUAL


- Connectivity issues disrupt sessions
- Not everyone understands technology
- Access to fast and stable internet remains limited in many provinces.
- Low result reporting, follow-up gap.
- Telehealth workload, small team, high demand.
- Limited supply of HIV Self-Test Kits, stock comes from government allocations, affecting availability.





## WHAT'S NEXT: SCALING VIRTUAL HIV CARE IN THE PHILIPPINES

- Expand coverage through Amping (Visayas & Mindanao), Kabayan (countries with OWWA offices), and Embrace Plus (chat-based support).
- Integrate with PhilHealth, the national health insurance program.
- Include reproductive health, hormone therapy, and mental wellness.
- Strengthen automation so Telehealth teams can focus on more human-to-human conversations where they matter most.
- > Evaluate better outcomes, adherence, retention, and client satisfaction.
