Where can I access the courses?

All IAS+ courses are available on the "Courses" page: <https://plus.iasociety.org/all-courses>

How do I enrol in a course?

Follow these steps: 1. On the "Courses" page, select the course you are interested in and click the red "View course" button. → 2. On the individual course page, click the red "Start course" button. → 3. Log in with your existing IAS account or create a free account. → 4. Click the red "Enrol me" button.

How long are the courses?

The duration of courses vary. Please refer to the estimated duration for each course on its individual page.

Are the courses available in languages other than English?

Currently, all courses are available only in English.

Are there any fees or costs associated with the courses?

No. All courses on IAS+ are open access and completely free of charge.

Do I need any additional material to progress through the courses?

No. All necessary material and information are provided within the course itself.

Do I get any certification or credits for completing the course?

Upon completion, you'll receive a certificate of completion. However, these courses do not offer academic or continuing medical education (CME) credits.

How can I access my certificate?

Certificates are automatically generated upon course completion. After filling out a feedback survey, you'll be able to download your certificate.

I am experiencing technical difficulties with the course. What should I do?
